Specific Proposed Changes

• Add Northfield Hospital to the PERA Privatized Employee chapter.

Policy Issues Raised by the Proposed Legislation

- 1. Implications of using privatization model; privatized employees better off, PERA-General forfeits some actuarial gains.
- 2. Special consideration due to other bills introduced to reduce deferred annuity augmentation in PERA plans and to increase PERA-General contribution rates.
- 3. Issue of whether PERA-General receives some gain.
- 4. Existence of local support.

Potential Amendments

<u>Amendment LCPR05-067</u> removes considerable language from the bill made unnecessary due to receipt of actuarial work.

Amendment LCPR05-068 is a technical amendment that is needed if Amendment LCPR05-067 is not used, to indicate that work is to be performed by actuary jointly retained by the pension fund administrations rather than by the actuary retained by the Commission.
