## **Specific Proposed Changes**

• Includes supplemental retirement plan employer contributions in PERA-General covered salary definition.

- Extends supplemental retirement plan status to local laborers pension fund.
- Increases the maximum employer contribution to trade union supplemental retirement plans to \$5,000 annually.

## Policy Issues Raised by the Proposed Legislation

- 1. Unresolved inconsistent policy on pension coverage for trade union personnel employed by local governmental entities.
- 2. Unclear policy on the role of supplemental retirement plans for public sector employees.
- 3. Appropriateness of redefining "salary" for PERA-General to include employer supplemental retirement plans.
- 4. Appropriateness of allowing "catch-up" contributions for 2002-2005 salary.
- 5. Appropriateness of extension of supplemental retirement plans to include the local labor union pension fund.
- 6. Appropriateness of increasing the \$2,000 maximum on trade union employer supplemental retirement plan contributions.
