- 6. Potential substantive change: discontinuation of past defined benefit plan contribution transfers to MSRS-Unclassified.
- 7. Potential substantive change: discontinuation of optional PERA-General membership for city managers.
- 8. Potential substantive change: elimination of various TRA savings clauses.

### **Potential Amendments**

#### **Technical Amendment:**

<u>Amendment LCPR05-169</u> adds clarification of service credit purchase provisions as suggested by plan administrators.

#### **Substantive Amendments:**

Amendment LCPR05-170 adds various employers with State Patrol Retirement Plan or PERA-P&F covered public safety employees to the police state aid program.

<u>Amendment LCPR05-171</u> repeals the optional MSRS-General membership provision for Governor's appointees.

<u>Amendment LCPR05-172</u> ends grandparenting of Civilian Bureau of Criminal Apprehension civilian employees in State Patrol Retirement Plan coverage.

<u>Amendment LCPR05-173</u> repeals the 1985 authority for new MSRS-Unclassified Program members to transfer past defined benefit plan contributions.

Amendment LCPR05-174 repeals the optional membership for city managers in PERA-General.

Amendment LCPR05-175 Replaces outside vendor retirement plan coverage for city managers with PERA-Defined Contribution Plan coverage.

Amendment LCPR05-176 repeals old, potentially obsolete, TRA savings clauses.
