Specific Proposed Change(s)

 Allows a consolidated volunteer firefighter relief association emerging from Aurora, Biwabik City, Hoyt Lakes, and Palo to pay a smaller pre-consolidation service pension amount upon consolidation than general law requires.

Policy Issues Raised by the Proposed Legislation

- 1. Appropriateness of the proposed exception.
- 2. Current and likely future financial condition of the affected volunteer firefighter relief associations.
- 3. Appropriateness of a potential expansion of the general law provision.

Potential Amendments

Technical Amendment:

Amendment LCPR05-153 improves the language and style of the proposed legislation consistent with the apparent legislative intent.

Substantive Amendment:

Amendment LCPR05-154 adds the Aurora/Biwabik City/Hoyt Lakes/Palo approach as a permissible alternative in the applicable general law.
