- S.F. 995 (Betzold); H.F. 2109 (Smith) adds five additional exceptions to the statutory covered salary maximum.
- S.F. 1206 (Betzold); H.F. 1250 (Smith) adds a single exception to the statutory covered salary maximum.

## Policy Issues Raised by the Proposed Legislation

- 1. Appropriateness of "other constitutional officer" exception.
- 2. Appropriateness of county attorney exception.
- 3. Appropriateness of local elected official exception.

## **Potential Amendments**

Amendment LCPR05-155 (Substantive Amendment) replaces current maximum based on the

salary of the Governor with a broad maximum one-year percentage increase in all public pension plan members' covered salaries as

potential alternative approach.

<u>Amendment LCPR05-156</u> (Technical Amendment) adds cross-references to the Minnesota

Statutes, Section 356.611, maximum to the various definitions of

"salary" or "covered salary."
