(a) 1.20 Any person who retired and is receiving a coordinated program retirement annuity under 1.21 the provisions of sections 354A.31 to 354A.41 or any person receiving a basic program 1.22 retirement annuity under the governing sections in the articles of incorporation or bylaws 1.23 and who has resumed teaching service for the school district in which the teachers retirement 1.24 fund association exists is entitled to continue to receive retirement annuity payments, except 1.25 that all or a portion of the annuity payments must be deferred during the calendar year 1.26 immediately following the calendar year in which the person's salary from the teaching 1.27 service is in an amount greater than \$46,000. The amount of the annuity deferral is one-third 1.28 the salary amount in excess of \$46,000 and must be deducted from the annuity payable for 1.29 the calendar year immediately following the calendar year in which the excess amount was 1.30 earned. 1.31

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2.1 (b) If the person is retired for only a fractional part of the calendar year during the initial
2.2 year of retirement, the maximum reemployment salary exempt from triggering a deferral
2.3 as specified in this subdivision must be prorated for that calendar year.

(c) After a person has reached the Social Security normal retirement age, no deferral
 requirement is applicable regardless of the amount of any compensation received for teaching
 service for the school district in which the teachers retirement fund association exists.
