#### **Introduction**

S.F. 1398 (Pappas/O'Driscoll), the second unofficial engrossment, contains the contents of the 2015 Omnibus Retirement Bill as Passed by the House and the Senate on May 17, 2015, and presented to the Governor as Chapter 68 on May 20, 2015.

#### Source Legislation for the 2015 Omnibus Retirement Bill

### General Summary of S.F. 1398 (Pappas/O'Driscoll), the Second Unofficial Engrossment

## Article 1: Interest Rate, Salary Rate, and Payroll Growth Actuarial Assumption Changes. (Derived from HF660/SF613)

• Amends the economic actuarial assumption specification portion of the Minnesota public employee retirement plan actuarial valuation reporting law by eliminating the 2011 select and ultimate interest rate actuarial assumption for almost all statewide and major local retirement plans, by reducing in most instances the future interest rate actuarial assumption to 8% for the applicable retirement plans, and by reducing in most instances the salary increase actuarial assumption and the payroll growth assumption for the applicable retirement plans.

# Article 2: Conforming Changes in Refund Repayment Provisions Related to Interest Assumption Changes. (Derived from HF660/SF613)

• Resets the refund repayment compound interest rate for the various statewide retirement plans other than the Teachers Retirement Association (TRA) and for the St. Paul Teachers Retirement Fund Association (SPTRFA), at the current 8.5% rate through June 30, 2015, and at an 8.0% rate after June 30, 2015.

## Article 3: Conforming Changes in Leave and Prior Service Credit Purchase Provisions Related to Interest Assumption Change. (Derived from HF660/SF613)

• Resets the prior service credit purchase payment determination interest rate for the various statewide retirement plans other than the Teachers Retirement Association (TRA) and for the St. Paul Teachers Retirement Fund Association (SPTRFA), at the current 8.5% rate through June 30, 2015, and at an 8% rate after June 30, 2015.

# Article 4: Post-Retirement Adjustment Financial Sustainability Trigger Modifications. (Derived from HF565/SF519; House St. Gov. Finance Amend. S1398-6A/Senate Finance Amend. S1398-1A)

• Clarifies the reduced rate post-retirement adjustment mechanisms of many statewide retirement plans and revises the post-retirement adjustment mechanism of the St. Paul Teachers Retirement Fund Association (SPTRFA) by increasing the minimum receipt period required to qualify for an SPTRFA post-retirement adjustment, by providing for a future post-retirement adjustment reduced rate if funded ratios fall below the current law rate restoration triggers for the plans administered by the Minnesota State Retirement System (MSRS), for the Teachers Retirement Association (TRA), and for the SPTRFA, and by eliminating the Consumer Price Index-based post-retirement adjustment mechanism currently applicable to, but never implemented by, the Public Employees Police and Fire Retirement Plan (PERA-P&F).

## Article 5: Contribution Stabilizer Provision Modifications. (Derived from HF566/SF518)

• Revises the member and employer contribution stabilizer mechanisms added to some or all retirement plans administered by the Minnesota State Retirement System (MSRS), the Public Employees Retirement Association (PERA), and the Teachers Retirement Association (TRA), by shifting the mechanism from a mandatory, virtually automatic, rate-setting procedure to an advisory procedure, by relaxing the specific increments of contribution rate increases or decreases to be imposed to resolve funding deficiencies or sufficiencies, and by specifying the circumstances that each of the governing boards should consider prior to forwarding its contribution rate change recommendation to the Commission.

### Article 6: Police and Firefighters Retirement Supplemental State Aid. (Derived from HF826/SF884)

• Exempts the recipient municipalities and nonprofit firefighting corporations from the pension plan funded condition termination provision for the Public Employees Police and Fire Retirement Plan (PERA-P&F) and the State Patrol Retirement Plan, making the supplemental aid to volunteer firefighters permanent.

# <u>Article 7: Statewide Volunteer Firefighter Retirement Plan Lump Sum Retirement Division Modifications.</u> (Derived from HF1204/SF1140)

• Clarifies the short service former defined contribution retirement plan alternative benefit for members of defined contribution volunteer firefighters relief associations that recently joined the statewide volunteer firefighter retirement plan, expands from 20 to 71 the number of lump sum retirement benefit levels available to be selected by the fire department on or after joining the plan, revises the timeframe and deadline date for electing retirement benefit level changes, and clarifies the eligibility for and computation of portable retirement benefits.

## Article 8: Statewide Volunteer Firefighters Retirement Plan Monthly Benefit Retirement Division Creation. (Derived from HF599/SF537)

• Expands the current voluntary statewide lump-sum volunteer firefighter retirement plan and fund from applicability solely to lump sum and defined contribution volunteer firefighter relief associations to also authorize the election of coverage by and transfer assets and administration from one or more of the current 22 monthly benefit or combination lump sum/monthly benefit volunteer fire-fighter relief associations by creating two divisions in the retirement plan, one for the original lump sum retirement plan participants and a new one of any monthly benefit retirement plan participants.

# Article 9: Volunteer Firefighter Relief Association Working Group Recommendations. (Derived from HF826/SF884)

- Delegates the specification of the procedures for the certification of volunteer firefighters relief
  association financial statements to the State Auditor's office, includes auditing and accounting services
  specifically in allowable administrative expenses, and requires multiple check signers for relief
  association disbursements.
- Permits the State Auditor to waive penalty for certain maximum service pension amount determination errors and clarifies ineligibility of lump-sum volunteer firefighters relief associations to grant post-retirement adjustments.
- Adds references to the 2013 police and fire retirement supplemental state aid to fire state aid references in various aspects of volunteer firefighters relief association benefit and funding provisions.
- Provides a default start date for membership commencement unless relief association specifies a different date and limits the number of relief associations to be associated with a fire department.

## <u>Article 10: Particular Volunteer Firefighter Relief Association Changes</u>. (Derived from HF41/SF61 and HF298/SF251)

- Provides an exception for the Roseville Volunteer Firefighters' Relief Association to increase the number of permitted retired board members as the active membership of the relief association and clarifies the disposition of plan assets as an asset of the Roseville city treasury upon the payment of the last annuity or benefit payment from the relief association.
- Provides a resolution to the future retirement coverage for firefighters after the dissolution of the current three-city form of the Centennial Fire District by permitting, with local approval by all three cities, current Centennial Fire Department firefighters who elect to do so to transfer their service credit and their proportional share of relief association assets to volunteer relief associations in adjoining or within the fire service areas.

## <u>Article 11: Small Group Retirement Changes</u>. (Derived from HF477/SF580; HF1521/SF1373; HF1717/SF1791; HF1803/SF1684; and HF1997/SF1877)

- Extends Unclassified Employees Retirement Program of the Minnesota State Retirement System (MSRS-Unclassified) coverage to part-time legislative employees.
- Grandparents into General Employee Retirement Plan of the Public Employees Retirement Association (PERA-General) coverage employees of the Minnesota River Area Agency on Aging transferred from regional development commission employment.
- Excludes certain current Minneapolis Park and Recreation Board trades personnel from PERA-General coverage.
- Authorizes service credit purchases for certain persons for pre-1996 Department of Revenue seasonal employment, for unreported St. Paul Public School System employment, and for unreported Nashville Township employment.

## Article 12: MSRS, PERA, and TRA Administrative Provisions. (Derived from HF284/SF54; HF285/SF55; and HF661/SF589)

- The continuing eligibility for MSRS-Correctional coverage for former employees of the defunct Minnesota Extended Treatment Options Program/Minnesota Specialty Health System-Cambridge is clarified as applicable if rendering direct patient care and treatment rather than services administration.
- The opportunity for a disabilitants to elect an optional annuity is clarified as occurring at benefit commencement, or if no election occurred then, at age 54¾ or 4¾ years of benefit receipt, whichever is later.

- The age at which a disabilitant transfers to retirement status is changed to age 55 from age 65 for disabilitants beginning to receive benefits after July 1, 2015.
- The trigger for a resumption of the full post-retirement adjustment rate applicable to retirees from the Legislators Retirement Plan is revised to be identical to the trigger for MSRS-General.
- An obsolete reference to the Minneapolis Employees Retirement Fund (MERF) is removed, conflicting membership for public body provisions are resolved, salary crediting for leaves of absence was generalized, an obsolete reference to the Community Corrections Act is removed, leaves of absence provision references are revised, the PERA disabilitant service credit restoration is revised, a reference to vocational rehabilitation is updated, the annuity accrual provision is reorganized, the disability post-retirement adjustment eligibility provision is revised, and the PERA-P&F and PERA-Correctional disability payout limitations are clarified.
- The termination definition is revised to require a 30-day separation from any governmental subdivision than the particular governmental subdivision, but permit independent contractor work for another governmental subdivision within 30 days without affecting the validity of the retirement.
- The definition of "volunteer firefighter" used to exclude emergency on-call firefighters from PERA-General or PERA-P&F coverage is extended to firefighters covered by the statewide plan.
- A 12-month service credit purchase maximum is applied to service periods with reduced salary credit
  purchases and an exemption for temporary workers' compensation service purchases is added to the
  post-disability prohibitions of service credit.
- The PERA board of trustees powers provision is expanded to permit the board to specify procedures for electronic signatures on forms and applications.
- An independent disability determination organization or a licensed physician replaces the Department of Health physician as the PERA medical adviser.
- A department head may designate a representative to certify the annual list of employed personnel exempt from PERA-General membership.
- The optional annuity form election opportunities for a PERA-P&F disabilitant are revised to match recent revisions in the PERA-P&F disability program.
- The positioning of provisions is revised, references to "normal" disability benefits are replaced with references to "single life" disability benefits, and limits are clarified as being on a monthly basis.
- The option for private ambulance services with a governmental operating subsidy to participate in the PERA Defined Contribution Plan is eliminated.
- Conforming changes are made to the 2013 limitation of the privatization retirement benefit law to
  hospitals and medical facilities and the application of various aspects of the 1998 PERA-General law on
  disability coverage rather than the current PERA-General law for privatized employees were eliminated.
- A provision is added to the public employee Social Security coverage chapter to handle the cost of any future Social Security referendums and a generic reference to police and fire retirement plans is replaced with the appropriate statutory citation.
- Adds a minimum vesting requirement of six months service credit in each retirement plan with coverage to be eligible to utilize the proportionate annuity provision.
- A duplicative provision including Range Association of Municipalities and School Districts in PERA-General coverage, three outdated grandparenting provisions, and an obsolete restriction on contributions by former elected officials to the PERA Defined Contribution Plan are proposed for repeal.
- The reemployed annuitant earnings limit for TRA retirees reemployed by the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities System (MnSCU) is shifted from a calendar year to a fiscal year period, effective retroactively to January 1, 2015.
- For strike periods and leave periods, the interest-free period on service credit acquisition payments is extended by six months.
- To comply with the federal Uniformed Services Employment and Reemployment Rights Act (USERRA) and retain the plan's exemption from federal income tax, for post-December 31, 2006, military member deaths, additional benefits obtainable from any Minnesota public pension plan had the military service member returned to active plan coverage before dying are extended to the survivors, retroactive to January 1, 2007.
- To comply with the federal Internal Revenue Code, for optional annuity forms, the optional annuity must be converted to a single life annuity using the plan's interest rate and mortality table or a default interest rate and mortality table, whichever produces a greater amount, retroactive to January 1, 2005.

### Article 13: Obsolete Date Revisions and Various Clarifications. (Derived from HF1508/SF1398)

- Long-distant date-specific clauses in the allowable service provisions of MSRS, PERA, and TRA are eliminated as being obsolete in application.
- Effective dates for the 2009 revision of the post-retirement adjustment mechanism and for the 2010 temporary adjustment rate reductions included in the codified provisions for MSRS-administered plans, PERA-administered plans, and TRA are eliminated as being obsolete.
- Obsolete effective dates included in various pension plan provisions, various obsolete transitional pension plan provisions, and various obsolete internal pension plan provision date references are eliminated as no longer necessary.
- The definitions of "approved actuary" in MSRS, PERA, TRA, and first class city teacher laws are revised so that they conform with the "approved actuary" definition in the general actuarial valuation reporting law and the general actuarial valuation reporting law "approved actuary" is expanded to include actuarial firms as well as individual actuaries.
- Replaces general cross-references with specific cross-references, adds writing requirement for
  exemption requests, clarifies various references, updates the language usage and style of various
  retirement provisions, and repeals various obsolete retirement provisions.

### Article 14: PERA-MERF Merger Provisions. (Derived from HF1508/SF1398)

- Completely merges the Minneapolis Employees Retirement Fund (MERF) into the General Employee Retirement Plan of the Public Employees Retirement Association (PERA-General) by eliminating references to the separate entity of the former MERF Division of PERA.
- Sets the local employer supplemental contribution to PERA-General on behalf of the former MERF-Division at \$31 million annually for Calendar Years 2015 and 2016, and at \$21 million annually for Calendar Years 2017 through 2031
- Sets the state contribution to PERA-General on behalf of the former MERF Division as follows: on September 15, 2015 and September 15, 2016, the state shall pay \$6,000,000, and by September 15 of each year after 2016, the state shall pay \$16,000,000.
- Eliminates the \$3.9 million employer additional contribution.
- Allows former MERF members, while employed in a position transferred to PERA-General, to continue with basic plan coverage rather than switching to a plan coordinated with Social Security.
