Advisory Committees

Minnesota Statutes, section 3D.13 provides that “an advisory committee, the primary function of which is to advise a particular state agency, is subject to sunset on the date set for sunset review of the agency unless the advisory committee is expressly continued by law”.

It is not completely clear what advisory groups are “associated with these agencies”.

- The following likely are associated with one or more of the health-related licensing boards:
 - Acupuncture Advisory Council,
 - Athletic Trainers Advisory Council
 - Council of Health Boards
 - Health Licensing Advisory Councils (several groups)
 - Health Professionals Services Program Advisory Committee
 - Licensed Traditional Midwifery Advisory Council
 - Occupational Therapy Practitioners Advisory Council
 - Pharmacy Continuing Education Task Force
 - Physician Assistant Advisory Council
 - Physician Assistant Advisory Council
 - Respiratory Care Advisory Council

Some other advisory groups involve health-related occupations, but appear to be “associated with” the commissioner of health, not one of the health-related licensing boards.

- Other advisory committees
 - The Urban Indian Advisory Board advises the Indian Affairs Council.

 - The Capitol Area Architectural and Planning Board Advisory Committee advises the Capitol Area Architectural and Planning Board
