- * The Statutory Mission of the Board is protecting the health and safety of the citizens and visitors of the state by licensing the practice of cosmetology.

Administrative & Licensing Division



- * The Board has over 14 different license types
- * Total Licensees: Over 41,000
 - Personal Licenses – over 35, 000
 - Salon Licenses - over 5,000
 - School Licenses – 44

Compliance & Inspection Division



- * Investigate and process approximately 125 complaints on licensed or unlicensed individuals per year.
- * Complaints are filed by either the public or the Board.
- * Inspect 3,000 salons per year
- * 43% of Salons are in the Metro with the rest out-state
